In my MA production I'm investigating family dynamics, creating a family portrait inspired by my own.

Coming from music composition and theater, I seek to create bridges and classes between art forms. I seek to immerse the performers in scenarios they have to solve. I believe that overwhelming the performer infuses dance with vitality. With obstacles, habits, and thoughts to go through, the performers gain a presence I experience in daily life. An authenticity I'm interested in. People of society traveling past each other, solving their problems on the go.

I'm inspired by the phenomena of thought patterns. A thought, whose origin we may not even know, can carve deep grooves in our brain if repeated enough, leading us to spiral into a fabricated reality where subconscious and conscious live together.

Negative thought patterns form the foundation of both the choreography and textual elements, emphasizing the experience of being ensnared in a pattern, both as a family and as a performer within the piece. The incorporation of live-composed sound and music serves to broaden the perception of the performer's psyche.

I love you

The phrase "I love you" intrigues me as an abstract concept worthy of research. During my M6 piece "Digital Nomad" in 2023, I developed a fascination with the lifestyles and emotional states of individuals who travel globally for remote work. Using platforms like Reddit and YouTube, I analyze physical and emotional expressions from influencers to initiate a dance piece exploring isolation, hyperventilation, and situation-based choreography. Integrating my personal experiences into the creative process, I strive to imbue honesty into the characters onstage through music, movement, and words. I'm particularly drawn to infusing performances with a strong and playful musical element.

As a musician composing my own music while choreographing, I'm focused on crafting a distinct identity for each piece. I view my music as an environment, working in tandem with scenography to create a world for the choreography to inhabit and thrive in. My choreography is inspired by situations I've observed or experienced in my own life, which I then translate onto the stage.

My musical approach investigates psychology, aiming to place the audience inside the performer's mind. Through sound, voice, and manipulation, I work to bring the performer's emotional state to the forefront. In my piece "Digital Nomad," I seek to depict a Western culture where people feel remote and become molded into the figure they aspire to be.

My research delves into the violence of the soul and the various addictions prevalent in both individuals and society. This encompasses addiction to media, the pursuit of love, the quest for validation, navigating truth in uncertain times, and the incessant need for resolution. Throughout my work, particularly in my MA studies, I grapple with emotionally weighty material, striving to grant it a voice.

As a composer, I am driven to elevate music and sound to the forefront, infusing performances with a sense of urgency. Central to my research is the utilization of sound and voice in character development, exploring the psychological nuances embedded within the rhythm and tones of both voice and sound.

In my MA project, a family drama, I delve into the various textures, effects, and themes that define each family member's rule of law. This extends to considerations of costume and scenography. My De De DOU focus lies in exploring the intricate interplay between different art forms. I aim to create a cohesive world where dance intertwines seamlessly with other artistic elements. My ultimate goal is to craft an immersive experience where the differentiant form De DOU allows for a dynamic exploration of reality, both for myself and for the audience.

As part of my MA, I'm exploring masculinity. The phrase "A man in contact with his feelings" is rare but deeply ingrained. Does society define a man by his public appearance, or is it his self-view, actions, and relationship with his feelings and thoughts? Collaborating with bodybuilder Magni for the project "Mars in Europe" sheds light on the desire to transform one's body: memories of adolescence, encounters with bullies, and the urge to assert oneself against the environment. Our connection deepens as we share personal memories while filming and creating sculptures at the seaside in Copenhagen.
